ALL APPLICANTS MUST SUBMIT AN APPLICATION FORM ALONG WITH SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS.

ALONG WITH THE APPLICATION FORM, THE APPLICANT MUST PROVIDE THE FOLLOWING:

- TRANSCRIPTS FROM MOST RECENTLY ATTENDED HIGH SCHOOL, COLLEGE, OR UNIVERSITY.
- RESUME
- TWO REFERENCES
- SHORT ESSAY NO MORE THAN 3 PAGES, ON WHY THE APPLICANT CHOSE THE CAREER THEY CHOSE AND WHAT FACTORS IN THEIR LIFE INFLUENCED THE CHOICE THEY MADE. IT MUST INCLUDE THE NAME OF THE PROGRAM THEY ARE ENTERING AND THE INSTITUTION IN WHICH THEY WILL BE STUDYING.
- PROOF OF ACCEPTANCE INTO PROGRAM OF STUDY BY THE EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTION.
